Dear Future Third Grade Parents and Students,

I am excited for a fun 3rd Grade year ahead! For Summer Math, I ask that your child spend 30-60 minutes a week on Math activities each week. I am flexible with the program or books you use to support your child in their math review this summer. This will be considered as the first "Math Observation" grade in August. Also, please review your child's subtraction and addition facts by using flash cards, songs, or any other Math games.

Exiting 2nd grade your child should be able to fluently add and subtract within 100, knowing single digit subtraction and addition within 20 by memory. Having mastery of basic addition and subtraction facts before entering 3rd grade is one of the keys to successful transition into the next school year. 3rd grade's math fluency focuses on multiplication and division and mastery of adding and subtracting within 100 leads to a smoother transition to learning multiplication and division facts next year. **I will be assessing students on their addition and subtraction facts the first week of school.**

Please, record math work on the provided log. **Logs are due on the first day of school and will count as your first observation grade in Math.**
