

## Summer Math for Incoming 4th Graders

**Dear Future 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Students and Parents,**

Your child should spend 30-60 minutes per week on Math activities during each week of summer. We are flexible with the program or books you use to support your child in their math review this summer. Their Math Log will be assessed as each student's first "Math Observation" grade in August. Also, please review your child's multiplication, subtraction, and addition facts by using flash cards, songs, or any other Math games. Students should come into 4<sup>th</sup> grade with strong addition and subtraction skills and have a basic knowledge of multiplication. Multiplication is a big part of math in 4<sup>th</sup> grade and students will do very well if they have their multiplication facts up to 12!
