Dear Parents,



We know we can count on you to move forward and help our students achieve their academic, social, health and wellness goals.

While our schools are taking full precautions to keep everyone safe at school and limit the spread at school as much as possible, I wanted to remind you that there are other infectious diseases, such as measles and chicken pox, which can impact our schools. That said, we need all our children to be up to date on their shots.

I urge you to make an appointment with your child's doctor now to get caught up on any required shots your child may have missed. If your child is 12 years or older, ask their doctor about how to get the COVID-19 shot. As you may be aware, doctors are taking extra steps to keep you and your family safe during in-person appointments. Please visit the CDC website to view the recommended [child](#) and [pre-teen/teen](#) immunization schedules. Please see the attached required CA Examination Form for School Entry that **MUST** be signed by your physician along with a copy of your child's recent immunizations or CDPH 286 form completed and **turned in BEFORE the first day of school, August 23, 2021**.
